Contact us at least 10 business days prior to when you need service to begin – visit njng.com, go to My Account and select the Stop, Start Existing Service tab. Or you can call us at 800-221-0051 and say "start service" at the prompt.

Mind the Meter This Spring

Spring has sprung – landscaping has begun. When planning to spruce up your landscaping make sure your natural gas meter is unobstructed so our crew has safe and easy access, especially in case of an emergency. Also, remember to:

- Use caution mowing your lawn or operating equipment around your meter.
- Don't cover the meter with mulch, soil or landscaping, which may lead to corrosion or rusting of the meter, resulting in a leak.
- Don't box in your meter or build a deck around or above it.
- Make sure your service line valve and meter aren't buried under hardscaping.
- Never tie anything to a meter or its piping including dog leashes. On days a meter read is scheduled, please take steps to ensure the safety of your dog and our crew by securing your pet away from the meter and path towards it.


